# **Activate Care Program**

Proactively engage members who have not seen their primary care provider (PCP) in the past <12 months>. Encourage them to schedule a visit and address any additional preventive care needs.

### Goals

- Enhance preventive care: Help members obtain necessary screenings, vaccinations and other preventive services to avoid preventable illnesses and complications.
- Address health disparities: Focus outreach on members who face barriers to care. Promote equitable access to healthcare services for all members, especially those in underserved communities.
- Reduce emergency room visits and hospitalizations: Encourage more PCP visits to lessen reliance on emergency services and hospital admissions.







# Des Moines Area Community College (DMACC) Certification Programs

Each fall, in partnership with DMACC, Iowa Total Care proudly offers scholarships to those who want to pursue or further their career in healthcare. Through these programs, students can earn a certificate that equips them with the skills to make meaningful difference in the lives of others.




### **School-Based Mental Health**

### **Hazel Health** (hazel.co)

Iowa Total Care is partnering with Hazel Health to provide access to school-based telehealth in multiple school districts across Iowa.

- No cost virtual, physical and mental healthcare that helps students stay engaged in learning.
- Help schools and families connect students to an lowa-licensed therapist.
- <17> proposed districts.









### **Classroom Clinic** (classroomclinic.com)

Iowa Total Care is partnering with Classroom Clinic to provide school districts with timely and convenient access to children's mental health services using telehealth and related technologies.

• Classroom Clinic does not replace the school's existing mental health services but enhances what the district already provides. They offer access to the Tier 2 and Tier 3 clinical services that are missing within the community.

#### Clinic services for students:

- Psychiatric evaluations
- Establishment of a diagnosis
- Medication management
- Individual therapy

#### Consultation services for schools:

- Mental health service coordination
- Team care conferences
- Challenging behavior strategies
- Teacher consults regarding at-risk students


