We believe that everyone, even people with significant disabilities, can and should have the opportunity to be fully employed in their community and take part in community life.



# Customized Employment/Customized Discovery

## ► Discovery


- 24–60 hours over 5–9 weeks; reveals vocational themes
- Assumes employability with the right job match & supports

## ► Job search planning (Visual Resume)

## ► Job development & negotiation

- “Job carving” and/or “Job analysis”

## ► Post-employment support

# Individual Placement and Support (IPS Model)

- ▶ IPS is an evidence-based practice for people with serious behavioral health disabilities.
- ▶ IPS is very successful at helping people get jobs of their choice.
- ▶ IPS is based on 8 practice principles,
- ▶ IPS programs are evaluated yearly by a Fidelity Review which measures how closely they follow the evidence-based practice model.
- ▶ Iowa's IPS State Trainers and Fidelity Reviewers work from the University of Iowa's Center of Excellence for Behavioral Health (CEBH)

# What is IPS?

*“IPS is a highly successful, evidenced-based model of supported employment that promotes a ‘recovery through work’ philosophy whereby individuals ... achieve competitive, integrated employment when assisted with ongoing support services.”*

# IPS Early Success!



- A young woman 19 yrs. old @ enrollment
- Had **30+** hospitalizations d/t serious mental illness **ages 17-19**
- Became employed through IPS, no more hospitalizations!
- Lost her job d/t COVID19, unemployed Mar-Apr-May 2020 and re-hospitalized 3x
- IPS Team helped her get another job May 2020, and she's remained stable in her mental health *and* her job ever since
- Using a PASS Plan she bought a car, moved to her own apartment, and has improved family & friend relationships
- *This is the kind of success possible with IPS for Iowans with SMI who want to work*

# From a mental health practitioner :

“I had someone crying in my office that I didn’t feel I could help, I thought she needed a higher level of care. She loved animals. [IPS Specialist] started working with her and found her a job at a kennel and she is a different person today and getting better and better. I saw all these boxes she needed to check first before considering work, but now all of those boxes are easier to check *because of work*. [IPS Specialist] is so caring and compassionate about what she does and goes above and beyond for everyone she works with.”

# Self-Employment

- Medicaid provides supported employment for self-employment similarly to what it does for CIE
- Voc Rehab has the Iowa Self-Employment Program (ISE)
