
# Overview



# Behavioral Health District Map





# A majority of people in all 3 roles are working part-time.


Full-time & Part-time All Roles

# The majority of Peer Support Specialists are working part-time.


Full-time & Part-time Peer Support

# A majority of Family Support Specialists are working full-time.


Full-time & Part-time Family Support


# The majority of Recovery Coaches are working part-time.

n=120




# The majority in all 3 roles are working in District 7.




The majority are working as Peer Support Specialists in District 1.




# The majority are working as Peer Support Specialists in District 2.






