

Notice of Intent to Release

To all interested parties:

The Iowa Department of Health and Human Services (the Agency) is providing this notice of intent to release a request for proposal (RFP) on or around July 2026 to fund approximately three High-Risk OB and Neonatal Transport projects that will strengthen Iowa's rural perinatal system by expanding EMS capacity to safely transport high-risk pregnant individuals and newborns to appropriate levels of care. These projects will equip EMS agencies with specialized training, tele-OB support, and neonatal-specific equipment to improve outcomes and ensure timely, coordinated access to advanced maternal and neonatal services. A core objective of this initiative is to establish consistent, reliable transfer patterns across a statewide hub-and-spoke network so rural facilities can efficiently route patients to the right care at the right time.
