### CCBHC Workgroup Recommendations

Item #	Description
1.	<b>CCBHC Panel Discussion</b> The CCBHC Workgroup recommends that the Council review and discuss the insights gained during the CCBHC panel discussion and use that information to develop further recommendations.
2.	<b>Peer Support Catchment Areas</b> The CCBHC Workgroup recommends that the Council learn where the peer support catchment areas are, and who is being reached.

### Children's Issues Workgroup Recommendations

Item #	Description
1.	<b>Youth Representation</b> The Children's Workgroup recommends the Council <b>create a formal process or structure to add youth representation</b> to the Council. Consider youth participation on Children's Issues Workgroup Consider youth participation on part of all of the Council meetings Explore additional approaches such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Conducting <b>youth surveys</b>,</li><li>• Reviewing existing data from youth-focused initiatives,</li><li>• Inviting ongoing presentations from HHS youth-related programs (e.g., youth input from 988 data).</li></ul>

### Older Iowans Workgroup Recommendations

1.	<b>Nursing Home Services for Individuals with Behavioral Health Needs</b> The Older Iowans Workgroup recommends that the Council invite representatives from Maximus to discuss PASRR determinations, mental health service verification, and nursing home level-of-care processes.
2.	<b>Cancer Prevention/Environmental and Lifestyle Health</b> The Older Iowans Workgroup recommends that the Council invite Janet McGinnis (Origins) to present on environmental health, lifestyle medicine, and lifestyle-change programming.

### Public Safety Workgroup Recommendations

1.	<p><b>Relevant Legislation</b></p> <p>The Strategic Planning workgroup recommends that members remain informed about proposed legislative changes related to public libraries, specifically the recently introduced amendment <b>H-8620 to SF 2432</b>, a bill concerning city health departments. This amendment includes significant changes affecting the governance and operation of public libraries. Members are encouraged to review the amendment and the bill in full to understand its potential implications and, if they choose, to contact their legislators with any questions or concerns.</p>
