TOGETHER TAILGATE RESIST

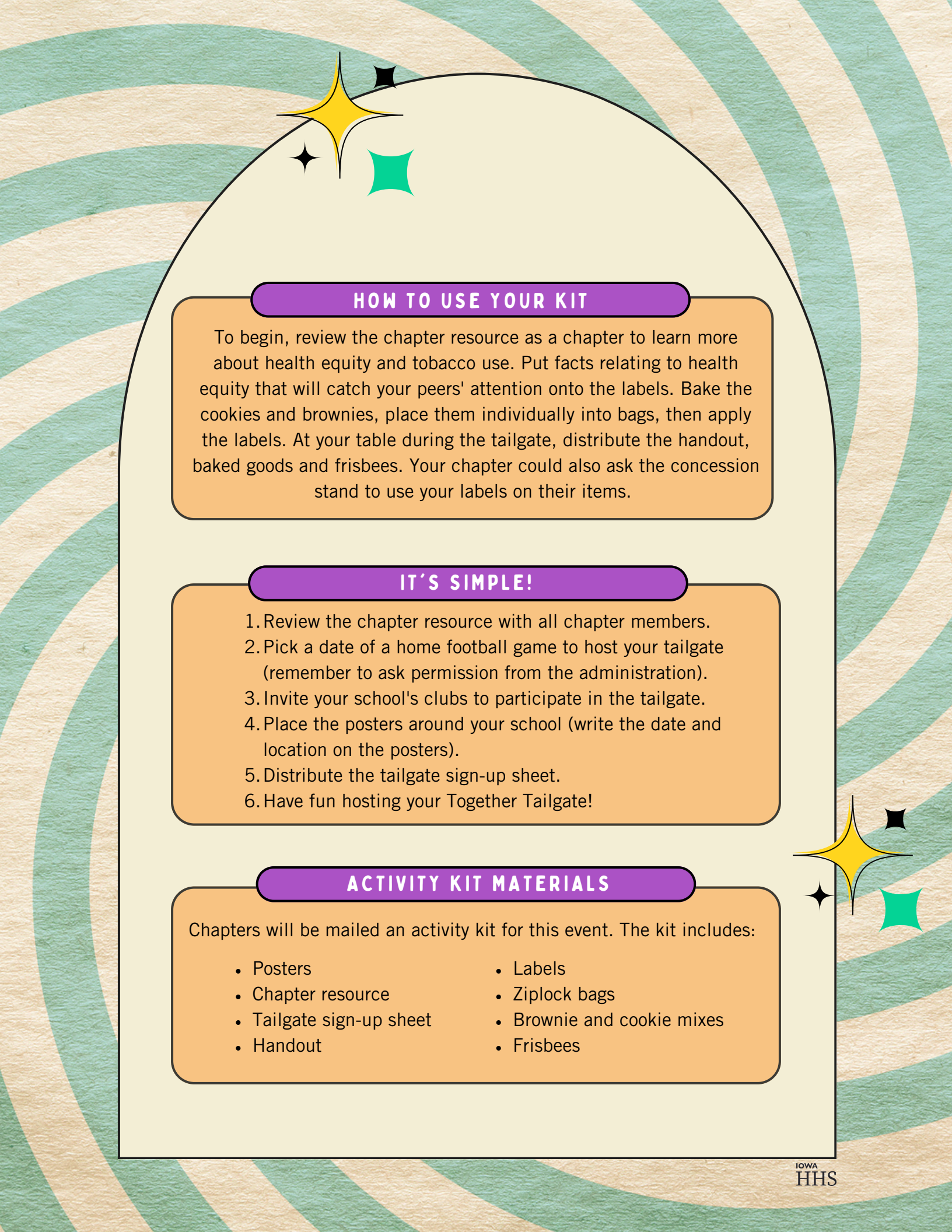
This event is a collaboration between the ISTEP Council and the Kansas Resist Council as a way to bring awareness to health equity and tobacco use. Other youth state tobacco programs will also be invited to participate as a way to spread the message across multiple states.

GET INVOLVED

During this event, put aside individual differences and accept people for who they are. Come together with a common goal to unify your peers by hosting a fun tailgate event and inviting your school's clubs!

Clubs are encouraged to participate as a way to spread awareness of their goals to their peers, but also to come together for one impactful event!

Clubs will sponsor a table, and include a food item and game to tie in the tailgate theme. Encourage clubs to connect their program to a health equity message whenever possible.



HOW TO USE YOUR KIT

To begin, review the chapter resource as a chapter to learn more about health equity and tobacco use. Put facts relating to health equity that will catch your peers' attention onto the labels. Bake the cookies and brownies, place them individually into bags, then apply the labels. At your table during the tailgate, distribute the handout, baked goods and frisbees. Your chapter could also ask the concession stand to use your labels on their items.

IT'S SIMPLE!

1. Review the chapter resource with all chapter members.
2. Pick a date of a home football game to host your tailgate (remember to ask permission from the administration).
3. Invite your school's clubs to participate in the tailgate.
4. Place the posters around your school (write the date and location on the posters).
5. Distribute the tailgate sign-up sheet.
6. Have fun hosting your Together Tailgate!
