Doing our part to cultivate fruitful opportunities for Iowans with disabilities

Following Wellpoint's recent \$1,800 donation to support the Easterseals Iowa community garden at Camp Sunnyside, Wellpoint Community Relations Representative Travis Gabeler volunteered alongside the Polk County Master Gardeners and Polk County ISU Extension. Together the volunteers pulled weeds, harvested fresh herbs, and washed and packaged the herbs for use in Easterseals programs. The Camp Cultivate garden provides fresh produce while offering individuals

with disabilities opportunities to build skills, promote wellness, and engage with their community.

As a Medicaid partner, Wellpoint is proud to support initiatives that improve access to nutritious food and foster healthier, more independent lives for the Iowans Easterseals serves. The \$1,800 donation was utilized for additional water irrigation equipment, tools, trellises and other supplies to support garden work.

On the last Wednesday of each month, Wellpoint hosts a community resource table at Operation Threshold in Waterloo, meeting families where they already access services like WIC and LIHEAP.

Supporting an essential hygiene resource in Woodbury County



In Woodbury County, Siouxland Community Health Center (SCHC) offers free showers to unhoused individuals and residents without a working shower with its mobile shower unit, which provided more than 1,500 showers in 2025. Wellpoint provided a \$3,000 sponsorship to support the purchase of nutritious snacks that can be made available to people who utilize the mobile showers.

Wellpoint joined the SCHC staff and mobile unit in June to provide tote bags and information about enrolling in Medicaid, as well as Wellpoint's services and extra benefits.
