Program Updates

SFY26 PreViser Updates

- Push for increased engagement so members complete their PreViser Oral Health Survey within the first 90-days of eligibility with Delta Dental
- Continue to see a large overall increase in DWP PreViser Oral Health Survey Completion
 - SFY26 goal to increase the number of PreViser Oral Health Survey received by members by 10% (when compared to last fiscal year)
 - A 132% increase in overall completion from SFY25 to SFY26

Workforce Updates

Foundation Overview: Spring Cycle

- 16 organizations received a combined \$937,086 to strengthen community health systems, expand access to care, and improve oral and overall health outcomes for lowans
- A total of \$680,086 was awarded to 11 organizations to focus on advancing oral health Initiatives
- Other funds used to support overall health, such as vision and mental health initiatives



Supporting Iowa's Future Workforce

- Innovative partnership between Eastern Iowa Community College and Community Health Center [Davenport]
- \$200,000 Foundation investment to launch a new Dental Hygiene Associate of Applied Science program at Eastern Iowa Community College in 2027 and to modernize clinical training facilities at Community Health Care for hands-on student learning
- Investment made to...
 - Expand training opportunities for future dental hygienists
 - Strengthen the oral health workforce pipeline in eastern Iowa
 - Increase access to oral health care for communities across the region
 - Support real-world patient care experience through clinical training and community-based care delivery

Outreach in Action

Outreach Spotlight: Vision Clinic and Health Fair

- DeltaVision and the Delta Dental of Iowa Foundation hosted a two-day vision clinic in partnership with [OneSight EssilorLuxottica Foundation](#), Prevent Blindness Iowa, and Oakridge Neighborhood Services
- 529 adults and children were seen, and 468 received prescription glasses!
- Hosted a community health fair with all three of the MCOs and other community resources
 - About 250 community members joined the fun and engaged with resources!



Storm Lake Updates

- Hosted a mobile clinic primarily focused on preventive services in March and identified members with restorative care needs
- Partnered with Dental Connections, Buena Vista Regional Medical Center, and Buena Vista University to provide restorative services and pediatric care to Storm Lake
- In one day, eleven clients were treated for 16 fillings, 2 sealants, 1 extraction and 2 pediatric exams/cleanings/fluoride
- In 2025 – provided funds to BVRMC to put in dental OR equipment and partnered with Pediatric dentist to bring services locally.
 - Over one year of success and have expanded from one to two OR days/month
