

Refugee Medicaid Changes

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Notices to Affected Population

Refugees, asylees, parolees, and a few others **will be subject to additional requirements** before being considered eligible for Medicaid.
(Example: a five-year bar will need to be met)

- ▶ From August to now, individuals HHS has identified as *potentially* no longer eligible will receive a letter directing them to notify HHS if they have an eligible immigration status.
- ▶ Individuals who are no longer eligible and will lose their Medicaid will receive a mailed notice from Iowa HHS. Iowa HHS will mail these notices **by September 20.**
