### I. Agenda/Minutes

### III. Substance Use Disorder/Problem Gambling Update – Lori Hancock-Muck

Ms. Decker was unable to attend today's meeting as she and Leadership at DHS are taking part in a 3 day virtual conference titled "Establishing a Comprehensive and Integrated Crisis System of Care". Ms. Hancock-Muck will provide Bureau updates in her absence.

Ms. Hancock-Muck gave an update on the Alignment between IDPH and DHS. The alignment process continues to move forward. Director Garcia and Faith Sandberg took part in a Presentation to House Human Resources Committee on January 11, 2022. The Presentation was titled "Health and Human Services Alignment". The slides are available on the alignment website. Ms. Hancock-Muck shared a reminder that the Preliminary Change Package is available on the website as well. Ms. Hancock-Muck stated that most recently the Executive Teams have been working on a Function Organizational Chart.

Ms. Hancock-Muck gave an update on the Opioid Epidemic and the death toll surpasses one million. Ms. Hancock-Muck shared that deaths due to drug overdose have topped a million for the first time since the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) began collecting data on the problem more than two decades ago. <u>A study released by the National Center for Health Statistics</u> found that 932,364 people died in the U.S. from fatal overdoses between 1999 and 2020. Separate data from the CDC estimates an additional 100,000 fatal overdoses in 2021. Unlike the COVID-19 pandemic which has hit elderly Americans hardest, overdose deaths have occurred in largely young and middle-adult populations.
