This office has received the CARF accreditation report and other required deemed status application materials. Your deemed status application is now complete. Thank you for the final documentation. Center for Alcohol & Drug Services, Inc. will be placed on the agenda for the March 9, 2022 meeting of the Iowa Board of Health Substance Abuse/Problem Gambling Program Licensure Committee. *Program representation is welcomed but not required*. The effective dates for your license will be October 31, 2021 to October 31, 2024. We have enclosed a technical assistance report detailing data reporting expectations with the transition of state data reporting systems.

Center for Alcohol & Drug Services, Inc. will be licensed to provide Adult Levels 1, 2.1, 2.5, 3.1, 3.3, 3.5, 3.7, and 4; Juvenile Levels 1 and 2.1 Substance Use Disorder and Problem Gambling Treatment Services; and Opioid Treatment Services.

Your current license, which expired October 31, 2021, remains valid until final action is taken by the Substance Abuse/Problem Gambling Program Licensure Committee on this application, per Iowa Code Chapter 17A.18.
