

## Immunization Registry Information System (IRIS) Benchmark Report Card Instructions 2 Year-Old Children and Adolescents 13-15 Years of Age May 2019

The following instructions outline the process to generate a Benchmark Report Card for childhood and adolescent immunization rates for an individual provider organization compared to the immunization rates of the state and county in which the organization is located. ## **Benchmark Report Card**

To generate a benchmark report card for pediatric and adolescent patients in IRIS, please follow these steps:

1) Select the 'benchmark report card' link under the reports section of the menu panel.

2) Select an evaluation period from the dropdown menu.

 Select a coverage rate option to generate the benchmark report card for childhood and/or adolescent age ranges. The childhood and adolescent benchmark report cards can be selected at the same time.



4) Select the gender desired for the report. Only one gender option may be selected for the report.



5) Enter today's date for the evaluation date:

6) Select the 'Generate' button. The Benchmark Report Card results screen will display. The results page will display the evaluation period and the birth date range for the childhood and adolescent rates. The immunization rates displayed will include the state, county, and the provider organization. The rates include the total number of records evaluated and the percent of patients meeting the benchmarks. To export the results, select the 'Export as a Spreadsheet' link. Immunization rates for the state and county will remain constant for the quarter. The immunization rate for the provider organization is determined by the evaluation date and will vary based on the date entered.
