The **Petitioner is responsible** for supplying the following documents to the Iowa Department of Public Health for processing after an Order to Amend has been issued from a court of competent jurisdiction:

- **641-99.6(6) (144) -** Entitled persons requesting an amendment shall submit the following to the state registrar:
- a. A completed and notarized amendment request on the applicable form as follows:
 - (1) Amendment to Certificate of Live Birth form.
 - (2) Amendment to Certificate of Death or Fetal Death form.
 - (3) Amendment to Certificate of Marriage form;
- b. A legible copy of a current government-issued photo identification or other identification documents acceptable to the state registrar;
- c. Certified copies of Order Amending Vital Record (Order must be signed by a Judge)
- d. The required fees pursuant to rule 641—95.6(144)

The fee is \$20 to amend a certificate of a vital record. Petitioner must return the original certified copy of the vital record to be amended to receive a new amended certified copy at no cost. All additional certified copies are \$20.
