



Presumptive Medicaid Income Calculation

If the pregnant woman (1) is age 18 or older; or (2) is married, divorced, or widowed; or (3) does not live with her parents or stepparents, go directly to Section II. If the pregnant woman is under age 18 **and** lives with her parents or stepparents, **and** is unmarried (or her marriage has been annulled), consider parental income in the eligibility determination as follows in Section I:
