## FIP-UP WORK PROGRAM DESIGNATED PARENT DECLARATION

One parent in each FIP-Unemployed Parent family must include the FIP-UP Work Program in the Family Investment Agreement. That parent is called the *designated parent*.

If only one of us is required to be in PROMISE JOBS, that person must be the *designated parent*.

However, the one who is not required to be in PROMISE JOBS can volunteer to be the *designated parent*.

If both of us are required to be in PROMISE JOBS, we must decide which one will be the *designated parent*.

We understand that we can change the *designated parent* if we both agree in writing. If we want to change the *designated parent* we must contact our PROMISE JOBS worker.

We choose \_\_\_\_\_ to be the designated parent. We understand that the one we choose to be the designated parent must participate in work program requirements that may include:

- Orientation, assessment
- Job club
- Working full-time
- Work experience while seeking employment
- High school, GED, or ESL if I am under age 25
