Use the following messages to share hearing screen results with families:

Pass:

"Your baby had a hearing screen and passed."

Pass with risk factors:

"Your baby had a hearing screen and passed. He/She does have one or more risk factors for hearing loss that can happen later.

Hearing should be checked again at 3 or 9 months of age. You and your baby's provider will receive a letter about this from the Iowa Department of Public Health."


Refer:

"Your baby had a hearing screen. The screen indicated that your baby needs further testing.

Another screen, provided by (<u>name/agency</u>) needs to be done before one month of age. Here is your appointment card. Call (<u>number</u>) with any questions."
