Use the following messages to share hearing screen results with families:

Pass:

"Your baby had a hearing screen and passed."

Pass with risk factors:

"Your baby had a hearing screen and passed. They have one or more risk factors for hearing loss that can happen later. Hearing should be checked again at 3 or 9 months of age. You and your baby's health care provider will receive a letter about this from the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services."

Refer:

"Your baby's hearing screening indicated that your baby needs further testing. Another screening provided by (name or agency) needs to be done before one month of age. Here is your appointment card. Call (number) with any questions."
