MEPD Information About Premium Payments

You are eligible for Medicaid for Employed People with Disabilities (MEPD). You will need to pay a premium for each month before you will get Medicaid for that month. Please save this important information about making the premium payments.

When to pay the premiums:

- **Remember,** Medicaid cannot pay your medical bills until your premium payment for that month is applied to your account.
- A bill will be mailed to you the month before the premium is due. You have until the 14th of the month that the premium is for to pay your bill. For example: If you get a bill in September for October, you will have until October 14th to make the payment.
- But, to make sure that you have Medicaid for the first day of the next month, mail your payment so that we get it by the end of the month in which you were billed.

For example: Send in your October payment so that we get it before the end of September to make sure that you will have Medicaid beginning October 1st.

How to pay the premiums:

- There will be an envelope with the bill you get each month. Use the envelope to mail your payment. If you lose the envelope, mail your payment to this address:

- You will receive your bill in the next few days. Please wait until you get your bill and pay the amount shown under AMOUNT DUE.
