Dental Stakeholder Workgroup

Focus: Access to care

- Maximize resources and recognize opportunities as they arise
- Increase collaboration, information sharing and partnerships
- Provide a blueprint for action to increase access to services

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Program Challenges Identified

- Lack of dentist accepting new patient referrals
- Lack of providers for surgical extractions and medically compromised cases
- Transportation needs and distance to access providers
- Treatment compliance
- Low reimbursement rates for services to providers
- Dental Health Professional Shortage Areas
 - 9 geographic counties (1:5000)
 - 57 low-income counties (1:4000)

Strategies in Process

Released a Dental Request for Proposal (RFP)

- Background Contracts currently open to any carrier with the ability to meet contractual requirements and pass a readiness review.
- Goals of the RFP are to procure the most qualified dental plans to demonstrate innovation, deliver high quality services and coordinate care and provide quality outcomes for members.
- Intended program outcomes include increasing member choice, increasing access to dental services, aligning all managed care contract requirements, oversight and accountability and ensure program stability.
- Notice of Intent to Award on November 1, 2023.

Strategies in Process

- Dental Rate Review
 - During the last legislative session, lowa Medicaid completed a comprehensive rate review for Medicaid providers and services, including dental.
 - Although the legislators did not allocate specific increases in the last session for dental services, they requested Medicaid to propose options to redistribute dental funds into preventative and diagnostic codes/services from areas above the rate benchmark.
