

Iowa NEMT & Waiver Program At-A-Glance

All complaints are analyzed for:

- Geographic trends
- Provider trends
- Type of complaint
- Members with multiple complaints

All complaints are investigated by contacting members, facilities, and providers to follow up and avoid repeat situations

PEP – Priority Experience Program

- Members experiencing challenges with their transportation can be entered into our PEP Program
- PEP is designed to provide a higher level of oversight and coordination
- Each trip is monitored and verified with the member, medical facilities, and transportation provider
- Members may be enrolled in PEP program based on:
 - Prior complaints filed
 - A greater level of need or attention required
 - Difficult to schedule transportation
 - MCO request for any reason

Currently:

- 86 members enrolled in PEP; 26 enrolled since 06/01/2023
- 4 of these members have filed complaints after PEP enrollment
