When you applied for SNAP, you chose to receive the standard medical deduction because you were paying a Medicare premium. Since the state is now paying your Medicare premium, you can no longer receive the SNAP standard medical deduction based on that expense. This may cause your SNAP benefits to go down.

If you have any out-of-pocket medical expenses, please contact me so I can determine if you still qualify for a medical deduction when calculating your SNAP benefits. Until I hear from you, your SNAP benefits will be calculated without any deduction for medical expenses.
