

Re: Notice to School: HHS supervision of a child

Legal authority: Iowa Code 232.2(4) requires HHS to ensure and provide documentation of the educational stability of the child while in foster care including, but not limited to, an assurance either that the department coordinated with appropriate local educational agencies to identify how the child could remain in the educational setting in which the child was enrolled at the time of placement (the School of Origin) or, if it was determined it was not in the child's best interest to remain in that setting, that the affected educational agencies would immediately and appropriately enroll the child in another educational setting. Iowa Code section 280.29 requires a school district or an

accredited nonpublic school, upon notification by an agency of the state that a child in foster care is transferring from one school to another, to provide for the transfer of all of the educational records of the child no later than five school days after receiving the notification. The receiving school is required to provide immediate and appropriate enrollment.

Consent and release of information: Any information provided or received, including this notice, shall be kept confidential and provided to only persons within your agency on a "need to know" basis. The Uninterrupted Scholars Act, which amended FERPA, permits the sharing of this notification and student information sharing with the case manager of a child in foster care without a signed release from the parent or guardian. (Health, substance abuse, child protection, and HIV information requires specific consent under the law and, therefore, is *not to be released* using this authorization.)
