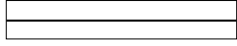

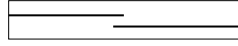

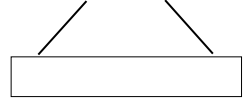

## Floor Plan Instructions

For licensing purposes, please use the enclosed pages to sketch a floor plan of your home. Use additional copies of page one as needed.

- Please use one page per floor of your home. Note the floor at the bottom of the page by checking the appropriate box.
- Bedrooms-please include the length, width and height of each bedroom.
  - Include the location and number of beds.
  - Include location of the door and what way it swings into the room.
  - Include the window measurements. Family Connections will need to measure the inches from the floor to sill. Family Connections will need to measure the opening width and opening height (this is the space that would be available to you to escape in the event of a fire, without breaking the window).
  - Write what kind of window it is and how it opens.
  - Draw in where the closet or dresser is.
  - Number each bedroom (BR #1, BR#2....)
  - If you have birth or adoptive children (children who live with you), write their first name in the bedroom in which they sleep.
  - Label the master bedroom, if you are willing to have a child ages 0-2, then we will need Family Connections to measure your windows too.
- Draw and label the smoke detectors, Carbon Monoxide Detectors and Fire Extinguishers on each floor.
- Include all other rooms on each floor, and label accordingly (kitchen, bathroom, living room, etc.).
- Include location of exits to the outside (including stairs from one level to another).
