Family Planning Program (FPP)



WHAT IS FPP?





Iowa offers a state Family Planning Program (FPP) which provides health coverage to individuals ages 12-54 with a limited income.

Benefits of this program include

-  contraceptive services and supplies
-  tests and treatments for sexually transmitted diseases
-  routine preventive services related to family planning

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for this benefit program, you must meet the following:

-  Iowa resident
-  U.S. citizen or qualified immigrant
-  Meet income limits (includes moderate incomes)
-  Males and females, ages 12-54

How Do I Apply?

You can apply for FPP at:

- Designated Title X family planning clinics
- Your local Iowa HHS office

What Documents Do I Need?

- Proof of citizenship (such as birth certificate or passport)
- Non-U.S. citizens need to bring immigration documents
- Proof of Identity (such as government issued driver's license or ID or student ID)
- Social Security Number
- Proof of income from last 30 days:
 - ▶ Pay stubs
 - ▶ Statement from employer
 - ▶ Child support received (payment record or court order)
- Other requirements may apply

Even if you don't have these documents you can still submit an application.
