

CHILD WELFARE AND CHILD CARE PAYMENTS

FOSTER CARE REIMBURSEMENT

- Licensed Foster Care
- Caregiver has a need for service (i.e. enrolled in school, has a job)
- No CCA provider agreement needed
- Paid by Foster Care funding
- Reimbursement is up to the maximum CCA Rate

CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE (CCA)

- Unlicensed relative or caretaker
- Caregiver has a need for service (i.e. enrolled in school, has a job)
- CCA provider agreement needed
- Paid through CCA
- Income of caretaker does not apply

PROTECTIVE CHILD CARE

- Unlicensed relative or caretaker
- May be used when a child is not in foster care, and there is
 - Open case of Child In Need of Assistance (CINA) or CPS assessment or
 - Ongoing case due to CPS assessment or
 - Adjudication or petition on file for CINA
- CCA provider agreement needed
- Paid through CCA

CHILD

- A person twelve years of age or younger.
- A person thirteen years of age or older, but younger than nineteen years of age, who has a defined developmental disability

CHILD CARE

- "Child care" means the care, supervision, and guidance of a child by a person other than the child's parent, guardian, or custodian for periods of less than twenty-four hours per day per child on a regular basis
- There are exemptions to this, which may include nominal fee programming, parks and recs programs, accredited camps, etc
