INVESTING IN IOWA CHILD CARE FUNDING

ABC DAYCARE, TABOR, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will provide start-up funds for a Registered Child Development Home for health and safety equipment and play equipment for the children indoors and outdoors. This project will add an additional 8 child care slots to the area.

ABC LEARNING EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

Funds will be used to renovate the second story, as well as repairs to roof, kitchen and current first floor classrooms to make them age-appropriate. This will add an additional 90 childcare spots throughout building.

ANDREW LITTLE LEARNERS, ANDREW, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand the three-year-old classroom. Funding to be used to meet requirements and to purchase developmentally appropriate materials. The project will add 27 additional slots to the program.

ANKENY CHRISTIAN CHILD CARE CENTER, ANKENY, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project includes renovating the current building to convert non-classroom space to approved classroom space. The project will expand the program by 20 slots.

ANN W. WICKMAN CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, ATLANTIC, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used for replacement of items needed to meet regulatory requirements including replacement of a water heater and ERV unit for the heating and cooling of the building.

BEEEN THERE CHILD CARE, UNDERWOOD, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to support replacement of items needed to meet regulatory requirements including the furnace/AC unit and electrical wiring.



BIG STARTS LITTLE HEARTS DAYCARE, CEDAR RAPIDS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This expansion project will allow the registered Child Development Home to use the basement as child care space by adding an egress window. This project will provide 8 additional spots to the community.

BIRDIE'S NEST CHILD CARE CENTER, DAVENPORT, IA

Award Type: Expansion and Urgent Regulatory

This project involves creating a new infant classroom and addressing regulatory requirements. Funding will be used for classroom materials, as well as health and safety renovations. This project will create a 100 new slots in the community.

BLESSED SACRAMENT ECC, WATERLOO, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will add 3 additional classrooms including required items for the rooms such as exit doors, sidewalk for fire safety, furniture, and supplies. Also they will be adding a fence with gate to outdoor play area, 4 more staff. The project will create 24 additional slots.

BLUFFS LITTLE THINKERS, SERGEANT BLUFF, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This is an expansion project with funds to update the playground and classrooms. The program will gain 10 new spots.

BOBCAT ACADEMY, MARSHALLTOWN, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will provide funds to support changing current space in the center to space to accommodate an additional 62 spots.

BOTTLE TWO BACKPACKS, GRUNDY, CENTER, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

Project includes bringing the center up to code and expanding following two fires in the church adjacent building. Funds will be used for materials, furniture, and appliances for kitchen and extra classrooms. The project will create 25 new spots.

BRANDY ROLF, CEDAR FALLS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

Funds will be used to double the size of business, increasing the available spots by 7. To achieve this, additional supplies, materials, and furniture need to be purchased.

BREDA DAYCARE CENTER, BREDA, IA

Award Type: Expansion

Project will remove fireplace of former residence and remodel to create space for 10 additional spots. Project also includes appliances, children's furnishings and health & safety equipment needed for the additional spots.

BUILDING BLOCKS ACADEMY, WOODBINE, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start up project included classroom furniture, play equipment, sound baffling for a large indoor play area, outdoor storage and equipment, and health & safety equipment. The center will provide 66 new child care spots to the area.

BURDS NEST LLC, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Start-up

Funds will be used to assist with opening costs of a Child Development Home including all furniture and supplies for child care. This also added office equipment and outdoor play center. The Child Development Home will provide 12 new child care spots to the area.

BURLINGTON AREA YMCA-CHILD CARE CENTER, BURLINGTON, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project awards expansion funding to purchase materials for additional 3-5 year old slots including classroom and outdoor equipment. The project will add 16 new spots to the community.

BURLINGTON AREA YMCA-KIDDIE CAMPUS AT SCC, BURLINGTON, IA

Award Type: Start-up

An additional location will be opened by the Burlington Area YMCA. Funds will be used to purchase materials for infants and 3-5 year olds, including classroom materials and outdoor play equipment. This project will provide an additional 46 spots to the community.

BUSY BEES, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project increase the capacity of the Registered Child Development Home by 4 spots. The project includes safety equipment, children's furniture and play equipment, and storage for outdoor play materials.

BUTTERFLY DREAMS CHILDCARE, GLENWOOD, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will allow the Child Development Home to increase capacity by 4 spots. The project includes installation safety features such as an egress window and rebuilding the basement staircase as well as storage for outdoor play materials and a commercial dishwasher.

CANDI'S CUTIES, NEWELL, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to repair several health and safety risks in the child care facility.

CARROLL AREA CHILD CARE CENTER, CARROLL, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to install a fire alarm system.

CAYDEN CARE LLC, DES MOINES, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to support meeting regulatory guidelines, including replacement of AC to maintain adequate temperatures and addressing a failing porch entrance into the Child Development Home.

CHILDSERVE, JOHNSTON, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will provide funds to renovate the current building to repurpose space into classrooms allowing an increase in enrollment of 26.

CHRISSEY PARKER, AMES, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to support replacement of multiple health and safety items as well as for equipment needed to support a safe sleep environment.

CHRIST THE KING DAYCARE, DES MOINES, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will address health and safety issues in the outdoor play space that are causing regulatory and safety concerns.

COMMUNITY UNITED CHILD CARE CENTERS, CEDAR FALLS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

Funds will be used to purchase a 15 passenger van to transport school age children, which will allow the program to accept more children from different schools in the area. Currently the program can only accept children that the school district will transport.

CONNIE MCKEEHAN-SMALL, BLOOMFIELD, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

The funding will address multiple health and safety needs to meet regulations.

CORAMAZE CHILDCARE, DAVENPORT, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will provide funding for a new Child Development Home, including purchasing child sized furniture and outdoor play equipment. This project will add an additional 12 spots to the area.

CUTE LITTLE ANGELS, IOWA CITY, IA

Award Type: Start-Up

This project is for a new Child Development Home for Spanish speaking and bilingual families. Funding will support health and safety items as well as age appropriate play materials. The project will provide an additional 4 spots to the community.

DAHLSTROM DAYCARE, MARION, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand this Child Development Home by 6 spots. Funding will be used to purchase additional age-appropriate indoor and outdoor materials to provide enough materials for all children.

DAWN'S DAYCARE, OAKLAND, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to address safety needs including front step repairs and installation of a sun shade at the Child Development Home facility.

DAY DREAMERS DAYCARE, DES MOINES, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will support safety items including wiring and HVAC as well as safe sleep options for infants in a dedicated Child Development Home child care space.

DUBUQUE DREAM CENTER, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start-up project includes minor renovations, updates to appliances to meet demands, adding outdoor play areas, purchasing vehicles, and new staff on-boarding. When open this new center will provide 200 new child care spots to the community.

EMILY KLENK, TAMA, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to install a fence to address a regulatory safety issue.

ESSEX CHILD CENTER, ESSEX, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to repair the roof and interior spaces as well as repair an air conditioning unit.

EXPLORATION AND LEARNING STATION, STUART, IA

Award Type: Expansion

The project includes health & safety equipment, play equipment, minor renovations for an ADA bathroom, appliances and an outdoor playground. The expansion will provide an additional 40 spots at this child care facility.

FAMILIES FIRST CHILD CARE AND LEARNING CENTER, WAVERLY, IA

Award Type: Start-up

Funds for this project will be used to help this brand new facility finish building the outdoor play area and storage area. It will also help with marketing. This new child care center will provide 105 new spots to the community.

FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER, MOUNT AYR, IA

Award Type: Expansion and Urgent Regulatory

The project includes purchases for the expansion such as an outdoor play area, classroom equipment, play equipment and additional appliances. Some funds will be used for needed bathroom and ceiling repairs. Once completed the expansion will provide 30 additional slots in this child care center.

FIRST STEPS ACADEMY, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This expansion project includes play equipment and child-sized furniture, office equipment and outdoor play equipment. Once completed this expansion project will provide an additional 4 spots at this Child Development Home.

GAN SHALOM PRESCHOOL, WAUKEE, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will provide funding for multiple regulatory concerns, including HVAC repairs and replacement of furniture causing safety issues.

GRUNDY COMMUNITY PRESCHOOL & CHILDCARE CENTER, GRUNDY CENTER, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to establish a second floor and lower level asbestos containment area to remove and dispose of the asbestos. Also will help remove and dispose of exterior pipe insulation and black tar.

GUARDIAN ANGEL PRESCHOOL, LE MARS, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used for needed safety repairs to flooring.

HAMPTON COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN DAYCARE, HAMPTON, IA

Award Type: Expansion

Funds will be used to increase enrollment by 60 children. To accommodate growth they will need 10 more staff, more storage, furniture, and play materials. The kitchen needs additional appliances, as well as an expansion to the outdoor play area.

HANCALTUU ABDIISAA, DES MOINES, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to address the safety issue of emergency exits by purchasing stairs to be used in the event an emergency evacuation is necessary.

HAND IN HAND AT EDWARDS, DAVENPORT, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will allow for expansion of an inclusive school age program for individuals with disabilities. Funds will be used to purchase all needed classroom materials and a van for transportation including a wheelchair lift. This project will add 37 spots to the community.

HAPPY HEARTS CHILD CARE, ANKENY, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will support the opening of a new Child Development Home including, start up supplies as well as health and safety changes needed in the outdoor space. This project will add 3 new spots to the community.

HAPPY HOLLOW PRESCHOOL AND CHILDCARE LLC-SOUTHWEST, CEDAR RAPIDS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand the child care for all age groups. Funding will support purchasing classroom materials, including cribs/cots and developmentally appropriate play materials. The project will add 50 new spots to the community.

HAWKEYE CHILD DEVELOPMENT: ALC, WATERLOO, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to repair damages to the infant room caused by a vehicle accident to the building. Materials and play equipment damaged in the accident will be replaced as well.

HAYWOOD FAMILY DAYCARE, DECORAH, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds were used to install a new AC unit as the previous one was no longer functional.

HEARTLAND CHILD DEVELOPMENT, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to for needed health and safety repairs such as window replacement, air conditioning/furnace repair, floor repairs and safety equipment.

HEARTLAND CHRISTIAN SCHOOL, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used for bathroom repairs, replacing a refrigerator and plumbing repairs.

HILLS AND DALES CHILDCARE CENTER, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to help replace the air conditioner unit for an indoor play space. This space is utilized for the child care program when weather is not appropriate for outdoor play.

I CARE CHILDCARE & PRESCHOOL, BURLINGTON, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand capacity by renovating the lower level of center to add additional classroom space, as well as bathrooms. Funding will also be used to purchase classroom materials and health & safety items. The project will add 22 new spots to this program.

I THINK I CAN: UNION COUNTY CCC, CRESTON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to replace the HVAC system.

IMAGINE CHILDCARE & LEARNING CENTER, NEWTON, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start-up project will provide funding to support health and safety concerns identified by the licensing consultant to allow better use of the property including bathroom renovation and playground improvement. The project will add an additional 88 spots to the community.

IMPACT ASC, TREYNOR, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project includes needed additions and renovations to the outdoor play area and security system to accommodation expansion. This will allow the program to add an additional 20 spots to their center.

ITTY BITTY CHILDCARE, MARION, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand the capacity of this Child Development Home by providing funding for an egress window. The project will provide an additional 4 spots in this child care facility.

ITTY-BITTY KIDDIE CHILDCARE, OTTUMWA, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will support expansion in a Child Development Home with funding for additional supplies necessary to expand hours and number of children. The program will expand by 6 spots.

JACK AND JILL PRESCHOOL, ATLANTIC, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

This project will provide funding for classroom equipment to expand the current program by 30 spots. Additionally some funding will go to meet regulatory guidelines including roof repair and water heater installation to ensure a constant temperature for the children's handwashing station.

JACQUELINE POST, FAYETTE, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will provide start-up funding for a Child Development Home, including outdoor and indoor play equipment as well as children's furnishings. This project will add 8 new child care spaces and is the only registered Child Development Home in this community.

JENNY'S DAY CARE, GARNER, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Project funding will be used to support updating the electrical systems as well adding a washer & dryer for appropriate sanitation and replacing a refrigerator to ensure adequate food temperatures.

JENNY'S TOT SHOP, CRESTON, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

This project includes adding an Egress window and fencing to support 4 additional spots in this Child Development Home. Additionally some funding was used to support replacement of a failing furnace to ensure adequate temperature control in the child care space.

JESSICA'S DAYCARE, SHEFFIELD, IA

Award Type: Start-up

Funds for this project will be used to add a outdoor play area including fencing, play equipment and storage. Inside it will add children's furniture and complete repairs to the stairs used to enter. This project will add 8 child care spots to the community.

JODY BASCUE, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project includes adding an egress window, outdoor storage and more children's furniture to accommodate 4 additional spots in this Child Development Home.

JUNIOR ACHIEVERS, ALTOONA, IA

Award Type: Start-up

Funding will support the opening of a new center, including basic health and safety items needed as well as age-appropriate materials for the children. The project will provide an additional 152 spots to the community.

KAREN COTA, WAUKON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds were used to support purchase of a new refrigerator and stove as the old appliances were not providing safe food storage and preparation.

KATIE MCDANEL, MONROE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will provide the funds for this Child Development Home to move into a dedicated child care space. Funds are being used to meet health and safety requirements in the space and will provide an additional 4 spots to the community.

KAYLA'S DAYCARE, ALTA, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start-up project will provide funds an outdoor play area including fencing and storage for play equipment. The facility will move from being a non-registered child care to becoming a Child Development home and adding 3 additional slots to the community.

KAYLIN'S CHILD CARE, SHELDON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will support a safety issue related to regulatory requirements by adding fencing to the outdoor space which is near a busy street.

KERRY'S KIDDIE CARE, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds included support for meeting a variety of health and safety issued related to regulatory requirements including repair of the roof, ceiling, gutters and fencing.

KID ZONE, WEST BURLINGTON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funding will support a safety issue related to fall surfacing in the outdoor play space.

KIDS COUNTRY CLUB, KALONA, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funding will support regulatory requirement to address safety of the outdoor play space.

KIDSPPOINT CHILD CARE, CEDAR RAPIDS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will support expansion at multiple locations throughout the area, including support for hiring new staff and marketing to parents. The project will provide an additional 246 spots to the community.

KOI POND MONTESSORI, FAIRFIELD, IA

Award Type: Start-up

The project will support start-up expenses for a new Child Development Home, including purchasing needed indoor materials, furniture and a fence for outdoor play space. The project will provide an additional 6 spaces to the community.

KRISTIN BEUTEL, DAVENPORT, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project supports expansion of a Child Development Home including needed materials such as cots, changing table and appliances. The project will provide 10 additional spots to the community.

KRISTINA NAIL, KELLERTON, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start-up project included funding for flooring, plumbing, sheet rock, roofing. Once open this Child Development Home will add 12 additional spots to the community.

LEARN AND GROW CHILDCARE, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to address a variety of safety issues including fencing in the yard, additional safety gates and adding a railing to the entrance steps.

LES ANGES CHILD DEVELOPMENT HOME, IOWA CITY, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project supports expansion of a Child Development Home including child-sized furniture, age appropriate materials and outdoor play equipment. The project will provide 4 additional spots to the community.

LIL' MUSTANGS CHILD CARE CENTER, GEORGE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project includes needed updates and additional materials for expansion including on the playground and in the classrooms. This program will be adding 50 spots.

LIL SCHOLARS NORWALK, NORWALK, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will support replacement of water damaged classroom.

LIL SPROUTS, CRESTON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This funding will support addressing multiple safety issues including, window replacement and flooring repairs.

LINDA BIRCHARD, CRESTON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This funding will support addressing a variety of safety issues including, fencing, flooring repairs and window repairs.

LITTLE ADVENTURES DAYCARE, NORTH LIBERTY, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will support start-up of a new Child Development Home, including age-appropriate materials and furniture as well as needed minor renovations. The project will provide 8 new spots to the community.

LITTLE ANGELS LEARNING CENTER, IOWA CITY, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will support expansion including advertising costs and supporting hiring of additional staff needed. The project will provide 28 new spots to the community.

LITTLE BLESSING CHILDCARE, DECORAH, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will be used to replace the central air conditioning to provide adequate temperature control for the child care space.

LITTLE PANTHER DAYCARE, PANORA, IA

Award Type: Expansion

The project includes needed equipment and renovations to support additional children; including a vehicle to transport to and from school, minor renovations and classroom furnishings. This project will add 19 spots to the center.

LITTLE PATCH OF HEAVEN, SHENANDOAH, IA

Award Type: Expansion and Urgent Regulatory

This project includes needed equipment and renovations for expansion as well as health and safety issues that needed to be addressed. It includes work on the flooring and restrooms as well as additional child furnishings. This project will add 4 spots to the Child Development Home.

LITTLE RASCALS CLUBHOUSE, NORA SPRINGS, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project included an outdoor play area, purchase of classroom supplies and adding a sidewalk for handicap accessibility. The project adds 45 new child care spots to the community.

LITTLE SPROUTS DAYCARE, MILFORD, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This start-up project included work on an outdoor play space and indoor renovations to meet fire marshal recommendations and DHS regulations. This program will provide 93 new child care spots to the community.

LIVE LAUGH LOVE CHILD CARE CENTER, MUSCATINE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will support expanding the infant classroom with funding approved to purchase materials for both the indoor and outdoor environment. The project will provide 5 additional spots.

LOUISE LAWSONE, HUDSON, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

This project provided needed equipment and renovations for expansion as well as some needed healthy and safety items, including an outdoor play set, a security system and deck railing/gate. This project will add 7 child care spaces to the community.

LOVABLE LAMBS CHILDCARE, KEOKUK, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project supports expansion in a Child Development Home including age-appropriate materials for both indoor and outdoor play. The project will add 4 spots to the community.

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will complete needed safety repairs per child care regulations and fire marshal recommendations.

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used for safety items in the outdoor play space.

MEGAN WALKER, HARTFORD, IA

Award Type: Start-up

This project will support the opening of a new Child Development Home, including purchase of a secondary exit to meet regulatory requirements regarding emergency exits. The project will create an additional 3 spots in the community.

MICHELE'S HOUSE CHILDCARE & LEARNING CENTER, EARLHAM, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used for safety including replacement of the outside emergency exit as well as safe sleep equipment for infants.

MICHELLE GRUHLKE, ESTHERVILLE, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

This project will provide funding to meet health and safety compliance standards.

MISS WENDY'S PRESCHOOL, HUXLEY, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to address regulatory health and safety issues, including repair of flooring, ceiling and air conditioning in the child care space.

MONTESSORI SCHOOL OF MARION, MARION, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project involves moving to a new location to expand. Funding will support needed classroom materials, minor renovations, an outdoor play space and a vehicle for transportation. The project will add 30 spots to the community.

MRS. SHYLA'S GARDEN, WALNUT, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used to make repairs to the air conditioning unit so that adequate temperatures can be maintained in the child care space.

NANA'S DAYCARE, MASON CITY, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will provide funds for the outdoor play area to allow expansion. This will provide an additional 4 child care spaces in this Child Development Home.

NOAH'S ARK CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, DUBUQUE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project will provide funding for renovations needed to expand including restructuring classrooms, plumbing and adding more fenced in areas for outdoor play. This will create 8 additional infant spots in the community.

Award Type: Expansion

This project will expand capacity of this program by using additional space available within center. Funding will support health & safety repairs, a new ADA bathroom and fall surfacing. The project will provide an additional 16 spaces at this center.

Award Type: Start-up

The funding will support start-up expenses for a new center. Items include needed equipment such as sprinkler system and outdoor play space as well as hiring staff.

PRINCE OF PEACE PRESCHOOL & CHILDCARE, CLINTON, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funding will support health & safety regulatory needs including roof and ceiling replacement.

PURPLE BLOOM SCHOOL LLC, CORALVILLE, IA

Award Type: Expansion

This project supports expansion of multiple age groups, including the school age program. Funding will be used for needed classroom and center materials. The project will provide 30 additional spaces to the community.

RED OAK CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, RED OAK, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

This project includes furnishings and equipment needed for expansion. Additionally some funding is supporting needed health and safety repairs including repair of roof, windows, and doors. This project will add 25 child care spaces to the community.

RUN A MUCK DAYCARE, WEST BRANCH, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

The funds will be used to address health & safety regulatory issues including replacement of the room and a water heater.

Award Type: Expansion

Funding was used to install and egress window to provide needed safety for expansion of child care spots. This project will add 4 spaces to this Child Development Home.

SCRI STEPPING STONES PRESCHOOL AND CHILDCARE PROGRAM, AVOCA, IA

Award Type: Expansion & Urgent Regulatory

This project included remodeling in kitchen and bathroom spaces to increase capacity as well as adding safety equipment to the outdoor play space. The project will add 11 child care spaces to the community.

SHAWN BOHL, MASON CITY, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funding will be used to meet health and standards issues in the outdoor play area.

SHEA'S LEARNING DAYS CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, COUNCIL BLUFFS, IA

Award Type: Expansion

The project provides funding for additional needed for expansion including in the outdoor play area as well as indoor furnishings, and Storage. This project will provide 11 additional child care spots to the community.

SHERYL MONSON, GARNER, IA

Award Type: Urgent Regulatory

Funds will be used replace the furnace and air conditioning which have stopped working and no longer keep adequate temperature in the building.
