**EPSDT:** Early & Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment.

**HCBS:** Home and Community-Based Services. Iowa has six waivers for these situations: Ill and Handicapped, Elderly, Mentally Disabled, Physically Disabled, Brain Injury, and AIDS/HIV.

**IRSH:** Intensive Residential Service Homes (IRSH) Habilitation Services.

**I-TABS:** Iowa Technical Assistance and Behavior Supports.

**ICF-ID:** Intermediate Care Facility for Intellectual Disabilities.

**ID:** Intellectual Disability.

**IDPH:** Iowa Department of Public Health.

**MFP:** Money Follows the Person.

**MHDS:** Division of Mental Health and Disability Services.

**PACE:** Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly.

**PMIC:** Psychiatric Medical Institution for Children.

**RCF:** Residential Care Facility.

**RCF-ID:** Residential Care Facility for persons with Intellectual Disabilities.

**RBSCCL:** Residential Based-Supported Community Living.

**SRC:** State Resource Center.

**Tertiary Care:** Highly specialized medical care over an extended period of time.
