Listed below are notable changes to the *Iowa LIHEAP Policy and Procedures Manual* for the FY23 program year. *These changes are in addition to those noted in the previous Program Notice, LIHEAP-PN 23-01.*

• 5.41 Eligible Dwellings

Non-subsidized housing

Non-subsidized households where heat is included in the rent are eligible provided they have a secondary energy burden (see <u>Appendix D</u> for more information). Non-subsidized households where both heat and electric are included in the rent are ineligible because the household has no direct energy burden with a utility vendor.

Subsidized housing

Subsidized households where heat is included in the rent are eligible provided they have a secondary energy burden (see <u>Appendix D</u> for more information). Subsidized households where both heat and electric are included in the rent are ineligible because the household has no direct energy burden with a utility vendor.

• 5.42 Ineligible Dwellings

Households with no direct energy burden with a utility vendor.
Subsidized and non-subsidized households where heat and electric are included in rent are ineligible because there is no direct energy burden on the household.

• 11.30 Household

 Removed language regarding making Direct Payments to non-subsidized households with both gas and electric included in rent to align with changes to non-subsidized/subsidized dwellings eligibility noted above.

• 10.00 Payment Matrix

Changed LP Minimum from \$600 to \$800.

• 15.22 Heating Unit Repair/Replacement – NOT with Weatherization

 Clarified that the Weatherization inspection can be performed by an agency Auditor, HVAC Technician, QCI Inspector, or a Weatherization Program staff person who has completed Weatherization-provided Furnace or Combustion Health & Safety training.

• 15.40 Emergency Delivery

- Changed Emergency Delivery maximum from \$600 to \$800.
