Pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 17A.18, 147A.7, and Iowa Administrative Code (I.A.C.) 641—131.7, the Iowa Department of Public Health is proposing to **DENY** your application for EMS certification.

The department may deny an application for EMS certification when it finds that the applicant has committed any of the following acts or offenses:

Fraud in procuring certification or renewal including, but not limited to:

(2) False representations of a material fact, whether by word or by conduct, by false or misleading allegations, or by concealment of that which should have been disclosed when making application for a certification in this state.

Knowingly making misleading, deceptive, untrue or fraudulent representations in the practice of the profession or engaging in unethical conduct or practice harmful or detrimental to the public. Proof of actual injury need not be established.

147A.7i; IAC 641—131.7(2)f

Violating a statute of this state, or the United States, without regard to its designation as either a felony or misdemeanor, which relates to the provision of emergency medical care, including but not limited to a crime involving dishonesty, fraud, theft, embezzlement, controlled substances, substance abuse, assault, sexual misconduct, or homicide. A copy of the record of conviction or plea of guilty is conclusive evidence of the violation.

The following incidents resulted in issuance of this proposed action:

You have been convicted of the following crimes:

- 1) Third degree burglary in 1998
- 2) Operating without consent in 1998

- 6) Fifth degree theft in 2003

In addition, you failed to report the convictions identified above as numbers 3 and 4 in your initial submission to the department. As of the date of this notice, you have failed to provide the charging orders and court disposition records for the burglary, operating without consent and theft convictions, as requested in letter a letter to you, dated December 8, 2008.

You have the right to request a hearing concerning this notice of disciplinary action. A request for a hearing must be submitted in writing to the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested, within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Notice of Proposed Action. The written request must be submitted to the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Lucas State Office Building, 321 E 12th St, Des Moines, Iowa 50319. If the request is made within the twenty (20) day time limit, the proposed action is suspended pending the outcome of the hearing. Prior to or at the hearing, the Department may rescind the notice upon satisfaction that the reason for the action has been or will be removed.

If no request for a hearing is received within the twenty (20) day time period, the disciplinary action proposed herein shall become effective and shall be final agency action.
