

## Iowa BDAP Formulary Exclusion List

The Iowa BDAP covers any medication prescribed by a physician unless it is listed on the BDAP Formulary Exclusion List or falls under a category listed on the BDAP Formulary Exclusion List.

If a client's insurance does not cover prescribed medication and an equivalent medication is not available on the insurance formulary, the BDAP may be able to cover the medication through the BDAP Medication Assistance Program upon request.

## IOWA BDAP FORMULARY EXCLUSION LIST

- 1. Abortifacients
- 2. Blood Sera
- 3. Non-FDA approved Compound medications
- 4. Durable medical equipment
- 5. Erectile dysfunction medications
- 6. Fertility medications
- 7. Hyaluronic Acid derivatives
- 8. Immune Globulin intravenous
- 9. Infusions
- 10. Injectable muscle relaxants
- 11. Provider administered medications/injections<sup>1</sup>
- 12. Medical cannabidiol
- 13. Schedule II controlled substances Percocet, Adderall, hydrocodone, methadone, etc. And cough suppressants that contain controlled substances hydrocodone, codeine, etc.<sup>2</sup>
- 14. Cosmetic medications Botox cosmetic, creams and ointments, etc. <sup>3</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Provider-administered long acting antiretrovirals (e.g., Cabenuva and Sunlenca) are covered by the BDAP formulary.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Due to a high risk of abuse and BDAP's mail-order model these are not covered by the BDAP. Other Ryan White funds may pay for these medications if arrangements are made with a local pharmacy.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Botox for non-cosmetic purposes is not covered by the BDAP. Other Ryan White funds may pay for these medications if arrangements are made with the provider's office and medical necessity documentation is provided.
