Radon Mitigation Credentialing Requirements

Addresses

All persons performing radon mitigation in Iowa.

Purpose

To clarify requirements for persons performing radon mitigation according to 641 Iowa Administrative Code, Chapter 44 "Minimum Requirements for Radon Mitigation". Licensed persons are required to meet all requirements as outlined in 641 IAC Chapter 44. This information notice clarifies specific requirements, but is not intended to preclude any other requirements.

Licensing

Any person who performs mitigation for radon in buildings, other than those which they own, in Iowa is required to be credentialed by the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of Radiological Health. Credentialing by the Bureau of Radiological Health is in addition to any certifications or training you may have obtained. If you are credentialed with the Bureau of Radiological Health, your name will be listed on the Iowa Credentialed Radon Mitigation Specialists document found on the IDPH Radon website <https://www.idph.state.ia.us/Radon/Fix.aspx>. **Persons performing radon mitigation without credentialing through the Iowa Department of Public Health are hereby notified that they should cease these activities.**

Persons determined to be in violation of the requirements of 641 IAC Chapter 44, to include the above requirements, may be found guilty of a serious misdemeanor.
