

Medicaid eligibility must be renewed each year. During the COVID-19 public health emergency, Medicaid for most members could not end. That requirement is ending. Members must now complete a renewal when it is sent to them over the next 12 months to see if their Medicaid can continue.

Starting in Spring 2023, members must complete a renewal for their Medicaid to continue, but everyone's renewal date is spread out over 12 months.

Follow these steps to determine if your Medicaid will continue:



Update your mailing address and contact information with lowa Medicaid.



Check your mail for the renewal notice letter.



Complete all requested information in your notice letter before the deadline.

If you lose Medicaid coverage, here are options to help:



Was coverage ended by mistake?

Contact the state agency to find out what information is needed from you to reinstate coverage.



Because of employment change

Check if health coverage is available through the employer.



If you need new coverage

Check other affordable plans available through the Health Insurance Marketplace[®].
