PRICING SPECIFICATIONS

NEICAC will provide all exhaust fans, switches and venting. The contractor is responsible for other supplies or materials in order to complete job. In most cases, the fans will already be installed, vented, and will only need to wired. All work must pass NEICAC inspection before payment can be authorized.

CONTRACT / AGREEMENT REQUIREMENTS

Winning bid contractors must complete an annual agreement with NEICAC. Contractors will be required to provide a copy of current and sufficient electrical licensing from the lowa Department of Public Safety. Other requirements include a current lowa Contractor Registration, Certificate of liability Insurance and Lead Renovator Certification through the lowa Department of Public Health. OSHA safety training is also a requirement and will be provided by NEICAC as appropriate.
