RE: Lead Paint Protocol Changes

## **Purpose**

The Lead Safe Renovation Report, Lead Test Kit Documentation, Lead Safe Training Documentation and Post-Renovation Cleaning Documentation forms have been replaced with a single form, *Iowa Weatherization Lead-Safe Report*.

## LEAD SAFE PROTOCOL

REPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED IN HOUSE FILE

- lowa Lead-Safe Renovation Report (required for all pre-1978 houses where LSWP are required):
  - o Weatherization house files must include a copy of this form, including all pictures, as applicable.
  - o If the contractor serves as the lead renovator, the contractor must keep the original for three years.
  - A copy of the completed form must be provided to the owner of the property and all other parties checked in Section B of the form within 30 days of completion of renovation
- Lead Test Kit Documentation Form
  - o All results positive and negative must be included.
  - e A copy of this form must be attached to the Iowa Lead-Safe Renovation Report, if applicable.
  - o Only required if pre-renovation testing is used.
- Iowa Lead-Safe Training Documentation Form
  - e Required whenever someone other than the en-site Certified Renovator works on the project.
- Iowa Post-Renovation Cleaning Verification Documentation Form (required for all houses requiring LSWP for interior work)
  - o Weatherization house files must include a copy of this form, if applicable.
  - o If the contractor serves as the lead renovator, the contractor must keep the original for three years.
  - e A copy of this form must be attached to the lowa Lead-safe Renovation Report, if applicable.
  - Iowa Weatherization Lead-Safe Report
    - Weatherization house files must include a copy of this form, including all pictures, as applicable.
    - If the contractor serves as the lead renovator, the contractor must keep the original for three years.
    - A copy of the completed form must be provided to the owner of the property and all other parties checked in Section B of the form within 30 days of completion of renovation
  - Notification Form
  - Pictures of containment

The new form contains all required information except the notification: Sections A - G and K - L replace the Renovation Report; Section H replaces the Test Kit form; Section I replaces the Training Documentation form; and Section J replaces the Cleaning Verification form.

Please note – the Notification Form and containment pictures are still required in the files.
