CONCUSSION AWARENESS MONTH 2022

An estimated **2.8 million** people sustain a TBI annually with a greater majority being mTBI also known as concussion.

The development of this project is supported by contract 5883BI06 from the lowa Department of Health and Human Services (Iowa HHS) Brain Injury Services Program.



PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Concussion is a type of brain injury that can be caused by a bump, blow or joit to the head or body; and is also referred to as a mild traumatic brain injury. Concussions can result from a variety of causes including falls, sports and recreation injuries, military action and IED blasts, motor vehicle crashes, intimate partner violence and physical abuse, assault, or other trauma; and,

WHEREAS, A concussion can happen to anybody regardless of age, race or gender; and,

WHEREAS. The majority of concussions occur without a loss of consciousness; and,

WHEREAS, The majority of individuals experiencing a concussion will have symptoms resolve in 1-3 weeks. However, some people may have long-term symptoms resulting from their concussion such as Chronic Traumatic Enceptablopathy (CTE); and,

WHEREAS, Providing academic adjustments, following graduated return to activity guidelines and using work accommodations are best practices for supporting individuals during concussion recovery:


