Proclamation Dated: February 7, 2021

(expires March 7, 2021)

SECTION THIRTY-FOUR. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6(6) and Iowa Code § 135.144(3), and in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Public Health, I continue to temporarily suspend the regulatory provisions of Iowa Admin. Code r 641-136.2(2) related to trauma data registry reporting by trauma care facilities within certain timeframes. I hereby direct the Iowa Department of Public Health to provide additional guidance to trauma care facilities regarding the effect of this suspension.

SECTION THIRTY-FIVE. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6(6) and Iowa Code § 135.144(3), and in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Public Health, I continue to temporarily suspend the regulatory provisions of Iowa Admin. Code r 641-137.2 and 137.3 related to initial and continuing trauma education requirements for trauma team members. I hereby direct the Iowa Department of Public Health to provide additional guidance to trauma care facilities and trauma team members regarding the effect of this suspension

Trauma Reverification Process

- Level I and II trauma centers: verified by ACS-COT
- Level III: On-site/Virtual visit
- Level IV: On-site/Virtual visit or paper review




Virtual Reverification Process

- Survey team remains the same – only remote
- Similar schedule to on-site visits (4-5 hours)
- Technology needs
- Added a technical test meeting with TPM 1-2 weeks out
- Recommend assigning a site visit coordinator

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: What date range do I use when filling out the SACA?
 - Facilities can choose the “From/To” dates
 - Start with where you are caught up in the registry and go back 12 months
- Q: Does our TMD need to show proof of continuing educational requirements for the state trauma verification?
 - ATLS is the only state requirement for the TMD
 - Level IV: general surgeon or EM boarded does NOT need to be current
 - Level III: TMD needs *current* ATLS



Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: I'm new to the TPM role and didn't get any guidance on what I am supposed to be doing. Is there anyone to help me?
 - Technical site (virtual) visit
 - Reach out to experienced TPMs at other facilities
 - Resources on the IDPH Trauma website
- Q: Is there a state guideline with regards to which service should be admitting trauma patients?
 - Best practice is that injured patients are admitted by a surgical service
 - Acceptable practice, especially for patients whose medical situation predominates, is admission by IM with surgical consult
 - Monitor through PIPS



Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: Should *{patient A}* be included in the registry?
 - Iowa Inclusion/Exclusion Criteria
 - Further questions to Danny Dowd – data analyst
- Q: On the SACCA, it says I need EMS protocols available. Do you need copies of all of them?
 - Not necessarily, but it is important that you can locate
