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Protecting and Improving the Health of Iowans

Proclamation Dated: January 7, 2021

(expires February 6, 2021)

SECTION THIRTY-EIGHT. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6(6) and Iowa Code § 135.144(3), and in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Public Health, I continue to temporarily suspend the regulatory provisions of Iowa Admin. Code r 641-136.2(2) related to trauma data registry reporting by trauma care facilities within certain timeframes. I hereby direct the Iowa Department of Public Health to provide additional guidance to trauma care facilities regarding the effect of this suspension.

SECTION THIRTY-NINE. Pursuant to Iowa Code § 29C.6(6) and Iowa Code § 135.144(3), and in conjunction with the Iowa Department of Public Health, I continue to temporarily suspend the regulatory provisions of Iowa Admin. Code r 641-137.2 and 137.3 related to initial and continuing trauma education requirements for trauma team members. I hereby direct the Iowa Department of Public Health to provide additional guidance to trauma care facilities and trauma team members regarding the effect of this suspension

TSAC Highlights – January 19, 2021 Meeting

- ACS “Orange Book” revision PDF to be published ~ March 2021
 - Criteria will be more clear and measurable (387 standards → 141 standards)
 - IDPH and TSAC verification subcommittee will work to review the criteria and determine next steps once published

 - Burn codes removed from 2021 NTDB inclusion criteria – still included within Iowa’s inclusion criteria
