# Community Health Assessment (CHA) Report for Cass County

Submitted: May 2022

Community Engagement: We collected data by administering a three-question survey to our Healthy Cass County coalition and additional county health partners identified by our planning team. We received 80 responses to this partner survey from people with experience working in sectors including education, healthcare, social work, mental health, local and state government, extension, domestic violence, home healthcare, public health, child and dependent adult protection, addiction, economic development, and more. After surveying our health partners, we administered a public community health needs assessment asking people who live and work in Cass County to help us prioritize nine health needs identified through secondary data, community asset analysis, and health partner surveys. 470 people provided feedback, and responses approximately represented the county population by geographic location, financial status, and race. Cass County Public Health will oversee the Cass County CHA CHIP with support of community partners identified in the CHIP and our Healthy Cass County coalition, which is open to the public and meets monthly.
