## State Index Searches:

<u>Death Records for the years 1880-1895</u>: Applicants must furnish both the county of occurrence and the year. A fee of \$15 for each year and county is required, with a copy issued if one is found. If the record is not found, a no-record letter will be provided. The fee may not be refunded.

<u>Marriage Records for the years 1880-1915</u>: Applicants must furnish both the county of occurrence and the year. A fee of \$15 for each year and county is required, with a copy issued if one is found. If the record is not found, a norecord letter will be provided. The fee may not be refunded.
