As a new member of the IA Health Link managed care program, you have been assigned to a managed care organization (MCO) for your health care needs.

Each member listed on the back of this letter has been given a MCO assignment.

Soon you will receive your member ID card from your MCO in the mail. Keep an eye out for this. You will show this card when you go to the doctor or receive services.

If you like your MCO assignment, you do not need to do anything. If you want to change, please follow the steps below.

Ongoing MCO selection process

- You have until the date listed on the front of this letter to change your MCO for any reason.
- Choice Counseling is available by calling Iowa Medicaid Member Services.
- If you need In-Person Assistance, call lowa Medicaid Member Services.
- You have **90 days** from the date your MCO coverage begins to change your MCO for any reason.
- You may change your MCO choice annually. You will be notified of your annual choice period.
- You may change your MCO at any time for reasons of "Good Cause." More information about Good Cause can be found in your IA Health Link Member Handbook.
