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Pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Sections 17A.18, 147A.7 and Iowa Administrative Code (I.A.C.) 641—131.7, the Iowa Department of Public Health is proposing to indefinitely **SUSPEND** the emergency medical care provider certification identified above.

The Department may suspend an EMS certification when it finds that the applicant or certificate holder has committed any of the following acts or offenses:

Willful or repeated violations of Iowa Code Chapter 147A or the rules adopted pursuant to that chapter.

IAC 641—131.7(3)s

Specifically:

The certificate holder must notify the department within 30 days of a change of address.
IAC 641—131.4(5)g

The following events have led to this proposed action:

On April 17, 2014, the Department attempted to deliver an audit request letter to you via certified mail at your address of record. The US Post Office indicated on May 8, 2014 that you had moved and left no forwarding address. The Department attempted to have the audit request letter delivered by the Jones County Sheriff's Office on June 2, 2014 to your address of record without success. Attempts to contact you at the phone number and email address of record were also unsuccessful.


Your Iowa EMS certification (I-08-207-12) shall be suspended until:

1. You provide the Department with a current address, phone number, and email address.
2. You provide verification of your continuing education hours for the certification period of April 1, 2012 through March 31, 2014.

You have the right to request a hearing concerning this notice of disciplinary action. A request for a hearing must be submitted in writing to the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested, within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Notice of Proposed Action. The written request must be submitted to the Iowa Department of Public Health, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services, Lucas

State Office Building, 321 E 12th St, Des Moines, Iowa 50319. If the request is made within the twenty (20) day time limit, the proposed action is suspended pending the outcome of the hearing. Prior to or at the hearing, the Department may rescind the notice upon satisfaction that the reason for the action has been or will be removed.

If no request for a hearing is received within the twenty (20) day time period, the disciplinary action proposed herein shall become effective and shall be final agency action.
