Gap in clinical supports statewide

Evaluate the reimbursement methodology for SCL



Evaluate the requirements and limitations of remote supports



Expand host home options and clearly define parameters



Develop and fund a pilot programs

Prioritize competency-based training



Consider policy changes to fund behavioral programming as a waiver funded service



Establish registry or central location for providers and MCOs



Bring crisis support providers to the table
