
#### THE STORY OF 'HOME'

### **CBS** evaluation

lowa's communitybased services (CBS) system is working better for some people than others.



We evaluated the parts of the system to learn what works well and what does not.



We found that lowa could better align services with people's needs to help the system work well for everyone.



Survey Iowans about what services are and aren't working


Needs-based waiver system
