

# Renew your Medicaid!

## Spring 2023

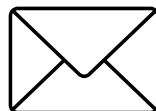
Medicaid eligibility must be renewed each year. During the COVID-19 public health emergency, Medicaid for most members could not end. That requirement is ending. Members must now complete a renewal when it is sent to them over the next 12 months to see if their Medicaid can continue.

**Starting in Spring 2023, members must complete a renewal for their Medicaid to continue, but everyone's renewal date is spread out over 12 months.**

**Follow these steps to determine if your Medicaid will continue:**



Update your mailing address and contact information with Iowa Medicaid.



Check your mail for the renewal notice letter.



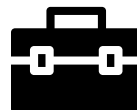
Complete all requested information in your notice letter before the deadline.

**If you lose Medicaid coverage, here are options to help:**



### **Was coverage ended by mistake?**

Contact the state agency to find out what information is needed from you to reinstate coverage.



### **Because of employment change**

Check if health coverage is available through the employer.



### **If you need new coverage**

Check other affordable plans available through the Health Insurance Marketplace®.
