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If an individual receives a title II benefit, any amount attributable to the most recent increase in the monthly insurance benefit as a result of a title II COLA is not counted as income during a "transition period" beginning with January, when the title II benefit for December is received, and ending with the last day of the month following the month of publication of the revised annual Federal poverty level.

For individuals with title II income, the revised poverty levels are not effective until the first day of the month following the end of the transition period.

For individuals not receiving title II income, the revised poverty levels are effective no later than the beginning of the month following the date of publication.

E. INSTITUTIONAL INDIVIDUALS

The levels for determining income eligibility for individuals and married couples sharing the same room under the provisions of 42 CFR 435.231, .722, and .1005 are as follows:

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Income Levels</u>
<u>1</u>	\$ <u>300% of the SSI benefit for one person</u>
<u>2</u>	\$ <u>For a married couple in the same room, twice the 300% benefit level for one person</u>

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INCOME ELIGIBILITY LEVELS (Continued)

F. SPECIFIED LOW INCOME MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES WITH INCOMES RELATED TO FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL

The levels for determining income eligibility for groups of specified low income Medicare beneficiaries under the provisions of section 1905(p)(3)(A)(ii) of the Act are as follows:

1. NON-SECTION 1902(f) STATES

a. Based on the following percent of the official Federal income poverty level:

Eff. Jan. 1, 1993 exceeds 100% but less than 110%.

b. Levels:

For persons described under Section 1905(p)(3)(A)(ii) of the Act, the income eligibility exceeds 100% of the Federal poverty level but is less than 110 percent in 1993 and 1994, and 120 percent in 1995 and years thereafter (as revised annually in the Federal Register) for the size family involved.

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
