

Barber Instructor Documentation Required for Licensure

Last Update January 2023

Prerequisite: Instructor applicants must be licensed as a barber in the state of Iowa for at least (2) two years.

Barbering Education

Prior submission of the official transcript or diploma sent directly to the Board office from a board-approved barber school verifying completion of 2,100 hours of education meets this requirement

OR

Prior submission of the official certificate of completion of the registered barbering apprenticeship from the United States Department of Labor

Barbering Experience

Official verification of licensure from every state where the applicant has held an active license in another state for at least 12 of the last 24 months directly preceding submission of the application. License verification documentation must be sent directly to the Board office by each state office where the applicant has been licensed, registered, or certified.

OR

Web-based verifications may be substituted but must include licensee's name, original issue date, current licensure status, expiration date, and any disciplinary action taken against the licensee
